**Transfers:** Disneyland Resort Express

-Present voucher to driver

-Inform driver of your hotel-*The Holiday Inn Anaheim Resort*

-Upon exiting baggage claim, proceed to the GTC (Ground Transportation Center). The Disneyland Resort Express picks up Guests in front of the ticket booth located to the left on a regular basis (est. time from airport to hotel is 30 minutes)

-The Disneyland Resort Express departs every hour on the half hour from 8:30AM-3:30PM and then at 4:45, 5:45, 7:00

## Recommended Route -Day1:

\*Daily Itinerary is a suggestion intended to make the most of your Disneyland vacation

\*PixieDustLady suggests you board the **Disneyland Railroad** in Main Street and depart at **Tomorrowland** as a quick alternative to walking

## Morning in Disneyland (open 10am-9pm)

### Suggested Lands>Main Street and Tomorrowland

\*Purchase autograph books and fat pens on first day

\*Get FASTPASS for **Star Tours / Space Mountain / Autopia**

- Board Monorail at **Downtown Disney** at 10am and get off in **Tomorrowland**
- Hit the must-see attractions in **Tomorrowland** and/or get FASTPASS if there are long line ups
- Late morning (or while waiting for FASTPASS times): walk to **Mainstreet** for pre-lunch attractions
- Lunch break (see "Dining" below)

## Afternoon in California Adventure (open 10am-8pm)

### Suggested Lands > Buena Vista Street and Paradise Pier

\*Get FASTPASS for **California Screamin' / Goofy's Sky school**

- Early afternoon: Proceed through gates to **Paradise Pier** –get FASTPASS
- Hit your other must-see attractions while waiting for FASTPASS times
- Late afternoon (or while waiting for FASTPASS times): walk to **Buena Vista Street** for pre-dinner attractions and shopping
- Dinner break (see “Dining” below)
